Dear Parents/Guardians,

Lincoln County School District #2 school closures began March 16, as recommended and then directed by Governor Gordon and State Superintendent Balow. These closures are in response to extraordinary circumstances for which a national emergency has been duly declared by the President of the United States under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act.

During the first week of building closures (March 16), staff at each building focused on preparing resources with the purpose of providing/distributing learning opportunities to all LCSD#2 students. While teachers began communication to parents/guardians, general education instruction was not provided or expected for any student during this first week of closure.

During the second week of building closures (March 23), teachers provided learning opportunities for all students and conducted remote support for at-home learning with the support of special education teachers and related providers.

IEP Meetings have continued to be held with parents and staff, with options to participate remotely.

A second communication to parents/guardians specific to their child's IEP programming to support LCSD#2's Adapted Learning Plan will be provided by April 17, 2020 via email from their child's IEP Facilitator.
