


Admin Role in Assessment Literacy

What again is assessment literacy?

Assessment literacy is the set of beliefs, knowledge, and practices about assessment that lead a teacher, administrator, policymaker, or students and their families to use assessment to improve student learning and achievement.

Three key standards administrators are responsible for regarding assessment literacy:

- Beliefs-What staff and students believe about student assessment.
- Knowledge-What staff and students should know and understand about assessment (in everyday language)
- Performance-Support the assessment literacy development of staff, students, and parents in your school
