

## ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

The Board recognizes that children have diverse capabilities and individual patterns of growth and learning.

The Board considers it important that teachers have as much and as accurate knowledge of each student's performance as possible in order to assess his needs, his growth, and make instructional plans. Thus, a sharing of information among parent, student, and teacher is essential.

### Report Cards

A written report of student achievement shall be issued to parents at the end of each grading period. The format of this written report shall be approved by the Superintendent of Schools and the principal of the school in which the form is used.

### Parent-Teacher Conferences

Parent-Teacher Conferences are encouraged- at least one per year on the high school level and one per semester on the elementary level.

The principal of each school shall be responsible for scheduling these conferences and making all other necessary arrangements. The scheduling will be cleared with the Superintendent in order to coordinate district programs.

Teachers may hold additional, individual parent-teacher conferences as the need arises.
