

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES. Leaders and staff encourage all students to participate in clubs, organizations, field trips, and school-sponsored events that extend learning beyond the classroom

- i. The district provides resources buildings, transportation for activities, and opportunities for all students to participate in a wide range of activities.
 - a. LCSD#2 has exceptional facilities, facilities are available for community events, youth programs
 - b. LCSD#2 provides nightly after school activity buses and a 4:30 tutoring bus on Tuesday and Wednesday <https://transportation.lcsd2.org/after-school-activity-buses/>
 - c. LCSD#2 provides transportation for field trips, sports activities and limited transportation for summer team camps
 - d. Multiple WHSAA sports and activities offered, school musical performances(number of kids involved in SVHS 48, CHS 60) and special Olympics, Swim N Learn, Mastery Camp, GOFASA and after school enrichment programs.
- ii. The district and schools use activity participation data as a measure of school culture and implement strategies to improve activity participation
 - a. LCSD#2 tracks student participation via the WHSAA participation form
 - b. Activity programs visit elementary schools to promote participation in activities
 - c. Activity programs volunteer services to the community to promote participation
- iii. The district provides coaches and sponsors and has a clearly defined process for adding new clubs, organizations, or teams
 - a. Policy IGD
 - b. Recently added sophomore coaches in volleyball and basketball to allow more students to participate
 - c. Recently added e-games club at the high school

ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. Leaders and staff encourage all students to participate in team sports and formal athletic activities.

 - c. Parent meetings are held with parent and player sportsmanship expectations at the beginning of every season
 - d. WHSSA yellow cards are used to remind parents of good sportsmanship
