

Music Offerings

Osmond Elementary is excited to offer three music choices for our 5th & 6th grade students during the school day of the 2017-2018 school year. The music choices are Orchestra, Band or General Music. Once a student determines their music preference they will be committed to that choice for the entire school year. Students will be grouped for their specials based on their music choice. Choices need to be submitted by May 4, 2017 to allow parents time to acquire instruments over the summer and allow the school time to group students and plan our specials rotation accordingly. Due to the complexity of grouping students for specials (Music, Art, P.E., Science, Technology) changes will not be considered.

Orchestra - Students will learn the fundamentals of playing violin, viola, cello, or bass. Students will be expected to practice regularly outside of class time and put on a concert at the end of the year.

Band - Students will learn the fundamentals of playing flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, or percussion. Students will be expected to practice regularly outside of class time and put on a concert at the end of the year.

General Music - Students will focus on guitar, but will also spend time singing and playing Orff instruments. They will also explore history, theory and other aspects of music in a more general sense.

Instruments for General Music:

Guitars are available for rent in the general music class, but students are NOT required to have an instrument for general music. If the student desires to rent a guitar from the school, the cost is \$25.00 for the year.

Instruments for Band and Orchestra:

Students must have an instrument. This can be an instrument that has been in the family or it can be rented from a music store or purchased.

Students in the 4th grade will be enrolled in General Music. They will purchase and play a recorder, explore history, theory and other aspects of music.
