Expectations and Rewards:

- Practice multiplication facts on the bus ride to Lava and at home.
- Free swim pass given to those who show improvement from math pre-test to post test.
- Listen to a book on the bus and write a daily reflection and summary.
- Earn a free swim pass for completing the writing each day or a book report.
- Read 30 minutes at home each day of lessons earn a free doughnut coupon.

Sessions 1-3 *You will pay only \$25.00 for each session and our grant will pay the rest.

- *Busing will be provided, leaving Etna Elementary and the District Office in Afton at 8:50 am.
- **Be there at 8:20 am on the first day!!!
- *Buses are expected to return to Etna and Afton around 2:00pm.
- **On the second to last day, a math post-test will be given before students are released.
- *Parents must arrange for transportation to one of these locations or to the lessons.
- * By reading, completing a summary of books listened to on the bus, and showing improvement in math facts, students will be able to earn a free doughnut coupon and 2 free swim passes for parents to take them swimming at Lava Hot Springs.

Session 4 Star Valley Ranch Cedar Creek Swimming Pool Monday through Thursday, August 6-9 and 13-16, 2018

Class Times: 9:30-10:00/10:00-10:30/10:30-11:00/11:00-11:30/11:30am-12:00pm

(We will let you know which class time you will have at least 1 week before lessons.)

- *You pay only \$25.00 for each session and our grant will pay the rest.
- *Lessons could be cancelled due to weather, but no refund will be given.
- *Parents will arrange for transportation to and from these lessons.
- **Be there 30 minutes early on the first and last day!!!
- ** By reading, completing a book report, and showing improvement in math facts, students will be able to earn a free doughnut coupon and 2 free swim passes for parents to take them swimming at the Star Valley Ranch Cedar Creek Pool.

- **Our Commitment to Learning:** Along with faithful attendance to swimming lessons, each student will be encouraged to read and practice math facts. Students will be able to earn **two free swim passes** by showing improvement in math facts and completing a reading assignment. Students may also earn a **free doughnut coupon** by reading 30 min at home each day of lessons and returning a signed reading chart. Students enrolled in Session 4 will need to complete all assignments at home.
- **Fees:** Your cost for swimming lessons is **\$25.00**. **Payment is due at the time of registration**. If you cannot pay, scholarships are available. (Please make checks payable to Etna or Osmond Elementary.)
- **Food: PLEASE send a lunch and water** with your child if he/she is participating in lessons at Lava Hot Springs. No snacks will be provided. Students will be allowed to eat their lunch on the bus ride home. **Please send lunch items that will not be messy on the bus and make sure all drinks have lids.**
- Sessions 1, 2, & 3 Transportation: Parents are responsible to get their children to Etna Elementary or Swift Creek High School by 8:50 am to catch the bus that will take them to and from lessons at Lava. Parents are also responsible to make sure their child is picked up at approximately 2:00 pm. Parents may choose to take their child to and from lessons at Lava themselves and not use the provided busing. Please let us know what works best for you. On the first day of class, all students need to come 30 min early, at 8:20 am. Students will stop at a Geyser in Soda Springs on the second to last day and we may stay longer to swim on the last day, so they will return 30 minutes later.
- **Session 4 Transportation:** Parents will be expected to arrange for transportation to and from lessons at SV Ranch Cedar Creek Pool. **On the first and last day of class, all students need to come 30 min early.**
- **Swimwear:** Girls' swimming suits must cover their midriff. If not, you are required to wear a t-shirt over your suit. Boys must wear swim trunks, which come to at least mid-thigh. Please follow school dress code.
- **Items to Bring:** Please wear a **modest swimming suit** under your clothes (follow dress code detailed above) and bring a **bag** for your wet clothes, a **towel**, **dry underclothing**, and a **jacket**. Bring **swim goggles** if you have them and label with your name. If you are attending Lava sessions, bring a **sack lunch and water**. For the Star Valley Ranch session and the last day of each Lava session, remember your **sunscreen**!
- **Items NOT to Bring:** Please do not bring any expensive or fragile equipment or toys. Students will not have time on the bus to use them. We will not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal items.
- **Multiple Lessons:** Students <u>will</u> be allowed to register for more than one session <u>only</u> if there is availability. Lessons will be assigned on a first come, first served basis, with priority given for every student to take lessons for at least one session before multiple sessions are assigned.

Swimming Level Placement

- **Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills:** This class provides students with opportunities for success with fundamental skills. (Front/Back floating and front crawl are taught.)
- **Level 3 Stroke Development:** Continuation of Level 2 with emphasis on front and back crawl and introduction to the butterfly stroke.
- **Level 4 Stroke Development:** The purpose of this class is to build student confidence and performance of the swimming strokes learned in Level 3 by providing additional practice.
- **Level 5 Stroke Refinement:** Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes, a pre-competitive class.
