Here's how it works:

- Clubs are filled on a first come, first served basis.
 Turn your paper in AS SOON AS YOU CAN!
- Enter a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice, not per day, but by session.
- \$5 fee helps defray the cost of materials and snacks.
- Depending on enrollment, students MAY be able to join more than one club. Emphasis is on everyone getting into at least one club.
- This session will run for 4 weeks, from April 2nd to April 24^{th.}
- Club lists will be posted on the Dry Creek Academy bulletin board by March 21st. No note is sent home letting kids know what club they are in!
- Please plan no consistent attendance. Please don't sign up for a class on a day that you may have another after school activity.
