Safety for students and staff is our top priority at Osmond Elementary. We work hard and invest significant time in training and collaboration with staff, law enforcement and medical agencies, as well as experts in the field of safety and security to utilize effective, research-based strategies to ensure the safety and well-being of our students and staff.

PREVENTION

• Law Enforcement Presence

 School Resource Officer, James Hunting, patrols our grounds and visits students and staff regularly. Other town and county officers also visit our campus regularly. We are grateful for our partnership with such caring and diligent officers.

• Physical Facility

- State of the art security cameras with views on all entrances, hallways, school grounds
- Access to cameras from multiple hardware throughout the building
- o "Lockdown" buttons immediately locks all exterior doors
- Card reader access locks
- Updated intercom system Allows all staff members to initiate any of the 5 emergency protocols from anywhere in the building
- Staff radios enable communication

• ID Badges Required

- o All staff
- All visitors required to obtain visitor badge after gaining clearance to enter building

o One entry point available

• Safe-To-Tell

O Anonymous tip line reporting system that shares information with local law enforcement and campus administration
