DRY CREEK ACADEMY Bevond the Classroom ~ Winter 2023




This session will run from January 9th to February 1st.

Winter Has Arrived!

A goal of our physical education department is to teach sports/activities that will keep students active throughout their lives. Skiing and snowboarding are an obvious choice as we are privileged to live in an area with abundant snowfall.

Thanks to your support of the fundraiser and reduced prices offered by Pine Creek Ski Resort, we are able to offer two days of skiing/snowboarding with instruction for each grade level.

If your child earned \$50 through the fundraiser, the lift ticket and rentals are covered for both days. If they did not participate, please make sure to have money to the school prior to their scheduled trips.

The cost is \$50 total for two days of lift tickets and two days of rentals. If your student has their own equipment that they will be bringing, they only need to pay \$15 per day (\$30 total) for their lift ticket or if they have their own equipment and a season pass, they will not need to bring in any money. If for some reason they need to rent equipment but have a season pass they will simply owe \$10 per day (\$20 total).

We are excited for this opportunity and know that the two days increase the likelihood that our young skier will taste enough success to instill a desire to continue. It is amazing to see how quickly they learn!
