




Michelle Stucki (Sarah Brown)


Fennec Burton (Cop)




KarLee Rosa (Mimi)

Guys and Dolls

"Guys and Dolls" is a beloved Broadway musical that premiered in 1950, with music and lyrics by Frank Loesser and book by Jo Swerling and Abe Burrows. 

The musical features memorable songs such as "Luck Be a Lady," "Sit Down, You're Rockin' the Boat," "Adelaide's Lament," and "I've Never Been in Love Before," all of which contribute to the show's enduring popularity.

"Guys and Dolls" is celebrated for its witty dialogue, catchy tunes, and lively dance numbers. It won the Tony Award for Best Musical in 1950. Since then, it has enjoyed numerous revivals and adaptations, solidifying its status as

a classic of American musical theater. Its timeless themes of love, redemption, and the clash between morality and temptation continue to resonate with audiences around the world.
