



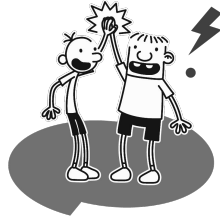

The National Museum of Wildlife Art:

Thursday, May 23, Thayne 2nd graders will see this art collection that features more than 550 artists and over 5,000 cataloged items of animal art. The collection chronicles much of the history of animal art, focusing primarily on European and American painting and sculpture.
