

### **In accordance with current Wyoming Public Health Order**

Parents, this is a summary of our current practices, procedures, plan, or requirements to comply with COVID related health orders. If you have questions please call Mr. Klein at the school.

- Face coverings
  - Students, teachers and school staff shall wear face coverings both indoors and outdoors where 6 feet of separation cannot be maintained. (Statewide Order effective August 1)
  - Some exemptions are allowed- medical condition, mental health condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering. Documentation will be required.
  - Alternate face coverings may be considered during the school day for instructional purposes.
- Transportation
  - Six foot spacing of students during transportation to and from the facility shall be maintained as much as practicable; face coverings shall be worn during transportation when six feet of separation cannot be maintained. (Statewide Order effective August 1)
  - Buses will be sanitized before each run.
- Recess
  - Students will be allowed to be outdoors for recess. Extra sanitization precautions of play equipment will be taken. Students, teachers and school staff shall wear face coverings both indoors and outdoors where 6 feet of separation cannot be maintained. (Statewide Order effective August 1)
- Positive test in classroom (student or staff)
  - LCSD#2 will work in collaboration with the Lincoln County Public Health Office. Considerations will be made for the following: communication, sanitization, temporary re-location of classroom and targeted closing based on public health orders.
- Lunch
  - 6 foot spacing will be maintained at lunch tables. Meals will be pre-packaged. Staff will deliver the meals.
- Cleaning/Sanitization
  - Additional measures for cleaning and sanitization will be taken, ie: additional custodial staff and disinfection of surfaces throughout the day. All cleaning products meet the requirements of the CDC and OSHA.
- Remote Learning vs. Virtual Learning
  - Remote- Classes delivered by a teacher located in a physical classroom with students present while also providing simultaneous remote instruction. Remote education instruction is delivered through interactive, synchronous technology which allows the student receiving the remote education to ask questions, make comments, and interact in real-time with the teacher, classroom students, and other remote students. Students must be enrolled in LCSD#2. Attendance will be taken morning and afternoon.
  - Virtual- Virtual education instruction is primarily delivered through technology and can be asynchronous or synchronous. Not available at this time from students in grades K-6. We are working on getting approval to offer this for students in grades 7-8. Students in grades 9-12 have this option available. Students must be enrolled in LCSD#2.
- Specials
  - Students will attend specials with their homeroom initially and music will be general music for all students to start the year.
  - Students will not wear masks for PE and will be outside as much as weather will allow.
- Visitors
  - Initially, visitors will only be allowed in the office. We will revisit this after the start of the year.
- Lunch
  - Students will be seated six feet from one another at lunch in 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade. 5<sup>th</sup> grade will eat outside as weather permits or in the classroom.
  - Microwaves will not be made available for students to heat home lunches.

**Screening Criteria**

Temperature	If 100.4 or higher not permitted to be present at facility
Temperature	If 99-100.4 + additional symptom not permitted in facility
Symptom Questions	1. Any shortness of breath? 2. Any cough? 3. Any lack of smell/taste? 4. Any unusual tiredness? 5. Known exposure?
<b>If showing symptoms</b>	<b>"Stay home--If symptoms are known, stay home"</b>

- Send your child to school with a clean face covering every day.
- Send your child with a water bottle. Drinking fountains will be shut off, but classroom faucets will be used as filling stations.
- Please do not send/bring classroom treats.
