Early Americans

- 1. The first Americans to inhabit North America came from Asia by way of a Land Bridge "Beringia" that connected Russia and Alaska
- 2. They were "nomads" people who wander following food (hunters/gatherers) and they followed the animals across.
- 3. Archeology the study of ancient peoples/cultures
- 4. Artifacts things such as tool, weapons, and other things left behind by early people
- 5. Carbon Dating a method of dating that measures the amount of carbon in something
- 6. Maize "corn" changed Indians way of life by allowing them to settle down, form communities and raise food rather than be nomadic.
