Learning Update

Kindergarten - Afton Elementary Kindergarteners have had an eventful and fun September. Last week we went on a field trip to Grover City Park and Grover National Forest. We were taught about the fire triangle of fuel, heat, and oxygen, collected forest scavenger items, and learned about which environmental objects burn quicker in comparison to others. At the end of our field trip, we got to see Smokey the Bear and learn about fire prevention. As we returned to school from this field trip, we learned about bus safety.

Moving on to the month of October, we are practicing number formations from 0-10, drawing basic objects using different shapes, and sorting items with different attributes. Kindergarten writers are learning to look at the world around them like a scientist. Students are learning to draw and label objects in their own writing. Nursery rhymes and zoo phonic sounds with actions are helping our reading acquisition.

On September 29th, we will have our first kindergarten sing and "Terrific Tiger" good citizen awards. 1st Grade - First Graders have been working hard this first month of school! We will continue to write small moment stories in our Narrative Writing Unit. We are working on handwriting and foundational writing skills to bring our stories to life. We are developing good reading habits, such as setting goals, smoothing out our voice, and reading more and more. We love "shopping" for new books. In Math we have been practicing number bonds and making ten. First graders will start adding numbers within 10 and learning new strategies to become fluent with math facts. We had fun on our walking field trip to Broulins. We had our first First Grade Celebration where we recognized some of our Royal Readers, Mighty Mathematicians, Writing Wonders, Wow Workers, and our Bucket Fillers! We are looking forward to all the fun, and new things coming in October!

2nd Grade - Second grade is looking forward to a great month of learning in October. This year we are including outdoor classrooms in our curriculum. We are using community resources to help us learn more about the world around us. In September we learned about milk and products that are made from milk. We would like to extend a special thank you to Kaylynn Nield with the Conservation District, FFA and Tyson Hepworth for teaching us about all things that are "DAIRYLICIOUS!" This month our special days will be October 7th and 13th. We will be learning about trees, fire safety, animal habitats, and animal adaptations.

3rd Grade - Third grade has settled into a nice routine. We can't believe September is already over. We are working hard on memorizing our skip counting and multiplication facts. Do you know a 3rd grade student? See if they can skip count by 3s or 4s. We think they'll be able to do it! We are in the middle of our narrative writing unit now. We've learned to include descriptions, feelings, and dialogue. We have also worked on making a good lead and conclusion. During reading time, we are learning so many cool skills to help us become better readers. One of those things is to stop to notice and question things in our books. Each of the third grade teachers is reading the book *Because of Winn Dixie* as a read aloud. So, this month we hosted a Winn Dixie Party for all third graders who earned their first reading goal. It was a lot of fun. We ate pickles and candy and had fun getting to know each other better. Keep reading at home!

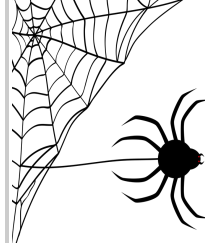
