**1st Grade -** It is hard to believe that we are almost one-fourth of the way through the school year! In November the first grade students will continue to develop reading strategies to solve hard words. Students will be working to develop reading fluency as well as comprehension skills during reading mastery and reading workshop. In math students will be developing an understanding of subtraction and then honing their addition and subtraction skills by working on their math facts. For writing students will begin the "How To" writing unit in preparation for informational writing later in the year. We are looking forward to a great month of learning, and feel blessed to have the opportunity to work with our first grade students.

**2nd Grade -** We are looking forward to Parent Teacher Conferences November 1st and 2nd. We're excited to visit with you parents about your amazing kids! We have been working hard on growing as readers, finishing our narrative writing, and learning place value in math the last few months. Students who are reading and practicing their math facts at home each night are showing the most growth so keep up the good work!

This month we are focusing on gratitude as a grade level. We will be participating in some acts of service and we will be writing letters to people who have done something kind or helped us in some way. Keep supporting your student from home.

**3rd Grade -** Third graders have been working hard at memorizing their math facts this month. We have introduced division and are learning how multiplication and division are related. Third graders spent a week in science classes learning about forces, weather. and natural selection. Writing has been lots of fun this month. Students got to choose the kind of writing they wanted to focus on the past few weeks. Choices included poetry, adventure, fairy tales, and graphic novels. In reading, we have started a nonfiction unit. We are reading interesting articles about things like termite mounds and tardigrades as we build our nonfiction reading skills. We are learning and growing daily! Keep reading at home and practicing those math facts!
