

Learning Update

Kindergarten - "Our favorite color is October!" -Unknown

In ELA, we have almost made it through all 26 Letters. As we wrap it up, we will loop back and work on learning the correct way to write letters. The sequence is based on letter strokes, so it will not be in alphabetical order. We have begun Heggerty, which focuses on building our Kindergarteners phonemic awareness through auditory-based activities. We like to think of Heggerty as the "warmup" before we start reading and writing. We will continue to work on name writing, focusing on appropriate use of uppercase and lowercase letters in our names. We are becoming amazing illustrators and are working on becoming exquisite story tellers. In Math, we will continue to work on number writing working up through 10. We will practice counting and comparing objects, making numbered sets, presenting numbers in different ways, and playing number games.

1st Grade First Graders have been working hard this first month of school! We will continue to write small moment stories in our Narrative Writing Unit. We are working on handwriting and foundational writing skills to bring our stories to life. We are developing good reading habits, such as setting goals, smoothing out our voice, and reading more and more. We love "shopping" for new books. In Math we have been practicing number bonds and making ten. First graders will start adding numbers within 10 and learning new strategies to become fluent with math facts. We are looking forward to all the fun, and new things coming in October!

2nd Grade - Wow! The first month of school went by so fast! We finished up our AIMS testing in September and were so pleased with how hard the students worked! We have some fun things planned for October in 2nd grade. We will have a few more special visitors come teach us. We will also enjoy celebrating Halloween!! We look forward to seeing everyones costumes! We introduced our CLASSY program to the students and are encouraging them to be kind and helpful kids, even when no one is watching. We want to build a community of kind, thoughtful students! Academically, this month we will be learning about place value with 3-digit numbers in math as well as focusing on reviewing math facts, their relationships, and strategies. We will continue to practice writing complete sentences, improving our handwriting, and begin working on narrative writing. Finally, as always, we will continue to work on building our reading skills. Some of the specific skills we'll be working on are: suffixes -ed/-ing, closed and open syllables,and compound words. Point these out as you find them in your reading at home. We encourage you to read, read, read at home! Find a fun fall or spooky book to share together this month. Thanks for all you do for your child at home. We appreciate your support!

3rd Grade - We got our vision and hearing checked, we learned bus safety, we finished all our initial testing, and we know what is expected in third grade. We are ready to learn!! We started our Narrative writing unit where we are learning how to write a good story that includes descriptions, dialogue, and complete sentences. We also started our fiction reading unit, focusing on being able to ask and answer questions from the text. In math, we are learning to multiply. Being a third grader rocks!!
