#### **Learning Update**

**Kindergarten -** We had so much fun trying our best for the Turkey Trot! The best part was watching lots of teachers and staff get pied! Kindergarteners will continue working on writing letters correctly and strengthening our phonemic awareness skills. Kindergarteners have begun a new writing unit called Show and Tell. During this unit we will work on paying close attention to details in illustrations to help "show" our readers something on each page. We are also working on adding more words to "tell" our readers about what is on each page.

Our mathematicians are working on comparing numbers by identifying which numbers are greater, less, or equal. We are continuing to review numbers 0-10 with a focus on number recognition, number writing, counting, number order, and playing various number games. Soon, we will move on to teen numbers and add numbers 11-20 to these activities. Between all of this hard work, we will manage to find time to spread some Holiday Cheer by attending Kindergarten Sing, School Sing, and various other Holiday activities. Happy Holidays!!

**2nd Grade -** Can you believe the holidays are here? The school year is flying by. We're going to work hard and see how much learning we can get done before we're off for Christmas break. We do have some fun things in store. We will write letters to Santa Claus and then take our 2nd grade traditional walk to Santa's mailbox to mail them ourselves. We will be working on our double digit subtraction this month so practice some subtraction math facts with them at home. This can be simple and done in fun ways such as with dice or game cards. But don't completely abandon addition since we would like the 2nd graders to be able to pass off their 5 minute addition timings by the end of December. We will be doing our winter oral reading fluency benchmark in December and hope all our students have grown in their reading skills from the beginning of the year. There are so many amazing holiday books out there, enjoy some with your child this month!

**3rd Grade** - We are into our third reading period now. We have some great, hard-working readers in third grade! We have studied both nonfiction and fiction texts. We are getting better at stopping to notice things as we read. Ask your students questions about what they are reading. They love to talk about the stories they read and the things they are learning. We have taught a couple science units. By the end of the year, each class will have rotated around to all the teachers for a total of five science units. In writing, we finished our fiction unit where students got to choose between writing graphic novels, poetry, adventure, or fairy tales. We are now working on our opinion writing. We are sure that in a few short weeks, your students will be able to convince you of almost anything! We wrapped up our unit on multiplication and division this month. Please keep skipcounting and practicing math facts at home. Students need a lot of repetition in order to transfer the knowledge to long term memory. We'll start addition and subtraction in December. Thanks for all your help and support!
